Many of you were praying for our flights back to Papua New Guinea earlier in October. We wanted to let you know that we really appreciate

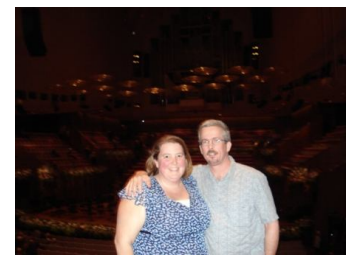
your prayers! Not one flight (of 4) was cancelled and we made all our connections....and so did our luggage! We also didn't have to pay any extras for our overweight bags.
